Dear believers!

As part of today's khutbah, we would like to present to you a few excerpts from the Farewell Sermon of the Prophet , which he delivered on Friday, the 9th of Dhul-Hijjah, in the Valley of Arafat, while sitting on his camel Qaswa, in front of 124,000 of his companions: "O people! Listen carefully to my words. Because maybe after this year I won't be with you anymore." O people! Just as these days of yours are holy days, just as these months of yours are holy months, just as this city of yours, Mecca, is a holy city, your life, your possessions, your honor and your reputation are also holy and protected from attacks. O my companions! Tomorrow you will meet your Lord. You will be questioned about your behavior today and you will be held accountable for your actions. Don't go back to the wrong path after me. Don't fight each other. O my companions! Whoever has been entrusted with a good should return it to its owner. All types of interest have been abolished. However, you have to pay back the original debts that you took on. Do not commit injustice and don't be oppressed! By Allah's command, interest has been completely abolished. companions! The custom of blood revenge from the time of ignorance has been completely abolished. O people! Do not take a false oath with the name of Allah. Fear Allah and respect the rights of women. You have rights to your wives and they have rights to you. O believers! I leave you with two things. If you hold on to them, you will never go astray. One is the Book of Allah and the Sunnah of His Messenger and the other is the Ehlul-Beyt. Even if a black slave is appointed over you, listen to him and obey him. A wrongdoer cannot be blamed for anything except his own crime. A father

cannot be held responsible for his son's offense, nor can a son be held responsible for his father's offense. O people! Be careful of four things: 1. Do not associate anything with Allah. 2. Do not kill anyone unjustly. 3. Do not commit adultery. 4. Do not steal. O believers! Hear my words and take them to heart. Your Lord is one, your father is one. You are all descended from Adem, who was created from dust. No one is better than another because of their ancestry. Preference from Allah comes only through piety. The Muslim is the brother of the Muslim. All Muslims are brothers. It is not permissible to lay hands on another's property unless you give it to them voluntarily. Do you want me to tell you who is a Muslim? The Muslim is the one from whose tongue and hand Muslims are safe. Shall I tell you who a believer is? The believer is the one from whom people's lives and property are safe. Shall I tell you who a muhajir is? The Muhajir is the one who emigrates from evil and sin. Shall I tell you who a mujahid is? The Mujahid is the one who fights with his Nefs. Listen carefully: On the Day of Judgment I can save some people, but not others. I will say: "O Lord, my companions!" and He will answer: "You do not know what they have invented after you in the name of religion." I am your forerunner who is waiting for you at Hawd-u Kawthar. O people! Beware of exaggeration in religion. For the people before you surely perished because of their excessive zeal. O my companions! Don't do yourself injustice. Your Nefs also has rights to you. Those who are here should pass this advice on to those who are not here. O my companions! There will be no more prophets after me. Fear Allah. Perform your five daily prayers. Fast in Ramadan. Pay the Zekah on your property. Obey your commanders. Then you will enter the paradise of your Lord. Oh people! If you are asked about me tomorrow, what will you say?" The Companions replied: "We bear witness that you have preached the Religion of Allah, fulfilled your duty and left us good advice. Then the Prophet saw raised his blessed index finger towards the sky and then said: "Witness it, O Lord! Witness it, O Lord! Witness it, O Lord!"
